strength 10 mg/ml, Indoco Remedies said in a regulatory filing. It is a generic equivalent to reference listed drug (RLD), Vimpat Oral Solution, 10 mg/ml, of UCB, Inc, it added. The company said the approved oral solution will be manufactured at its Verna facility in Goa. "This approval further reinforces our commitment to delivering high-quality healthcare to patients worldwide," Indoco Remedies Managing Director Aditi Panandikar said. Lacosamide Oral solution is used to treat partial onset seizures and primary generalized tonic-clonic seizures in adults and children with epilepsy who are at least 4 years old.

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
